DEDICATED EDUCATOR RECOGNIZED FOR HER IMPACT

WILLIAMSBURG, Va – On December 1, 2016, Dr. Cyndi C. Williams, Assistant Superintendent of Instruction for Patrick County Public Schools, was awarded a 2016 VASCD (Virginia Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development) Impact Award for her contributions to the children of Patrick County Schools. The Impact Award is given each year to “professionals who consistently challenge themselves and others to learn, grow and achieve at the highest possible performance levels,” the organization said.

A statewide organization, VASCD is comprised of more than 1,200 teachers, administrators, and higher education faculty. It is dedicated to advancing excellence in teaching, learning and leadership through the support of policies and programs that “are proactive and innovative in ensuring lifelong learning for all.”

In her nomination packet, Dr. Williams is described as promoting the success of all those around her through her work. A passionate educator who seeks a lesson in every opportunity, fostering an environment of growth and collaboration. Dr. Williams, a life-long resident of Patrick County, began her career as a teacher at Meadows of Dan Elementary, and later taught at Stuart Elementary before becoming the principal of Patrick Springs Primary School and Stuart Elementary. After leading Stuart Elementary School to numerous awards, Dr. Williams moved to the school board office in 2009.

“It is an honor and a privilege to serve the students, staff, and administrators of Patrick County,” explained Dr. Williams. “It is also an honor to work alongside great educators in our region and across the Commonwealth. Every day we learn and grow as educators, helping each other, and ultimately preparing our students for the future.”

Williams continued, “Our students depend on us to revolutionize education by taking the next step for excellence in every classroom, every day. I am grateful to my colleagues and VASCD for this award and will continue to seek valuable learning experiences for both students and teachers as we move forward.”
