Students will be asked to answer the following questions by selecting:

Always, Sometimes, Never, or I don't know

- 1) At your school, how often are students from a variety of races, ethnicities, or cultures included in social groups?
- 2) Students at this school treat other students from different races, ethnicities, or cultures fairly.
- 3) Adults at this school treat students from different races, ethnicities, or cultures fairly and with respect.
- 4) How often do students discuss different races, ethnicities, and/or cultures within a social group?
- 5) When there are major events related to race, how often do adults at your school talk about them with students?
- 6) My school will support students who speak out against racism.
- 7) Seeing students wear Confederate clothing makes me and other students feel uncomfortable.
- 8) Confederate apparel implies negative feelings towards minorities.
- 9) How often have you heard racial slurs on school premises?
- 10) How often have you personally felt or seen minority students feel singled out during classroom instruction?
