No. 25737 Budget Discussion

School board members had requested a work session in order to get more clarification on the 2021 - 22 school budget. Superintendent Gilbert reviewed with the school board the items they requested.

For clarification, the questions included personnel, duties, and numbers at different locations.

The questions also included the teacher's salary scale and the steps that are a part of the salary scale.

Most questions were answered in open session but a few were to be covered in closed session.

The questions answered in open session are as follows:

1. Why do we need so many (I'm counting seven) administrative assistants at the high school?

7 Administrative Assistants at PCHS

a. Duties include: Attendance, Bookkeeping, Guidance, CTE, Receptionist, Staff Attendance & Substitutes, Library

2. Custodial seems to be one or two at each school except the high school (and I get why we need more there) but Stuart Elementary has three. Why?

Stuart Elementary has the highest enrollment for elementary schools. There are 3 full time custodians.

Several years ago, SES had two full-time positions and two part-time positions. The school system also contracted cleaning through Coast to Coast. It was suggested by the board to look at this cost and see if it would be better to have our own people to do this service. The change was made then to three full-time positions.

3. I'm counting eleven maintenance positions, plus a director. Why so many? Is there a daily activity log?

We have eight maintenance personnel counting the director. We do have one administrative assistant for the Maintenance Department. We operate seven schools, the central office, and multiple buildings at the operations area. Maintenance requests/needs logs are maintained and completed at the direction of the Maintenance Director.

4. Trying to wrap my head around having four assistant principals at the high school. And a teacher making more than any of the four and almost the principal's salary.

4 Assistant Principals at PCHS

- a. Core area instruction & attendance, Supervises Math, English
- b. Guidance & Testing, Supervises SPED
- c. AD, Supervises Fine Arts, PE, Custodians, Cafeteria
- d. CTE & bus discipline
- e. Supervises Science & History, Oversees operation of the high school
- f. The administrators all split grade level discipline responsibilities

Other questions were answered in closed session pertaining to specific personnel.
